13 Someone in the crowd said to him, 'Teacher, tell my brother to divide the family inheritance with me.' ¹⁴But he said to him, 'Friend, who set me to be a judge or arbitrator over you?' ¹⁵And he said to them, 'Take care! Be on your guard against all kinds of greed; for one's life does not consist in the abundance of possessions.'

¹⁶Then he told them a parable: 'The land of a rich man produced abundantly. ¹⁷And he thought to himself, "What should I do, for I have no place to store my crops?" ¹⁸Then he said, "I will do this: I will pull down my barns and build larger ones, and there I will store all my grain and my goods. ¹⁹And I will say to my soul, Soul, you have ample goods laid up for many years; relax, eat, drink, be merry." ²⁰But God said to him, "You fool! St Andrew's Restoration

We are hoping that building work will begin on the West end of the church in early June. We are part of the City Restoration Programme, which means that the city will significantly subsidise work to restore the building, although we need to raise about \$350k as a contribution to costs of fees/design. We are very grateful to those members of the congregation who have already given, and to an overseas visitor who gave us \$20k for the work. Please do let us know if you have any contacts or businesses who we could approach to ask for funding, and who would be willing to give to restore a building that is an iconic Moscow landmark, and a symbol of hope that there can be reconciliation, and a growth of respect, understanding and trust between the West and Russia.
